Competitive Examination & Preparation

Context

ABIT has an inflow of students from all backgrounds of society who may or may not have access to guidance programme regarding the competitive examinations. Being an institution which believes in value-based learning, we have a Competitive Examinations & Preparation initiative which was established for coaching these students to compete for different examinations conducted by SSC and Banking examinations conducted by IBPS.

Aims

The aim of this initiative is to prepare students so that they can apply for different competitive examinations. The primary focus is imparting training to the students for taking up a career in administration. During these exams, students are tested for their aptitude, knowledge, and skills required for a particular line of study or work. The aim is to encourage the students for general reading, general observation and thinking power for reasoning and encourage them for facing various competitive examinations.

Objectives

- To provide a platform, for aspirants of competitive examinations, where they can get all the help and guidance they need.
- To guide students for Group Discussion and Interviews.
- To build among students a sense of awareness, provide guidance, necessary literature, brochure, and other information about various competitive examinations.
- To conduct career development seminars and workshops on competitive exams.
- To conduct mock interviews and train students in personality development and communication skills.
- To provide quality material in the form of books, magazines, newspapers, internet etc.
- To introduce them to various government and private jobs recruited through competitive examinations like SSC and Banking.

Course of Action

- Information to be given to students about the competitive examination preparations through class notice and registration of interested students to be opened.
- Classes to be started for the interested students.
- Assessments (VSTs) will be given to all the interested students from all departments participating for different competitive exams.
- Discussion of assessment tests will be done in the class and doubts cleared.

Implementation Methods:

The learning process involves various combinations of the below-mentioned modules. Depending on the learning capacity and capability of the students, different combinations will be decided by the track members and reviewers.

1. In Person Coaching classes: These classes are specifically designed for students who are preparing for banking exams and are looking for in-depth guidance and support. These classes usually include lectures, practice sessions, and mock tests to help students prepare for the exams.

2. Online classes: With the increasing popularity of online education, ABIT is now offering banking preparation classes also through online platforms. These classes are convenient for students who cannot attend regular classes due to time or location constraints.

3. Group study sessions: ABIT offers group study sessions for banking preparation, where students can come together and discuss concepts, practice questions, and share study materials. These sessions can be a great way for students to get feedback and support from their peers.

4. Specialized workshops: ABIT offers specialized topics related to banking exams. These workshops can help students get a deeper understanding of the concepts and practice questions.

5. Practice sessions: Practice sessions are essential for students preparing for IBPS and SBI exams. ABIT offers practice sessions where students attempt VST and get scores & feedback from experienced faculty members.

- 3. Offers a customized and individual attention, most of the time aspirants find it difficult to complete the whole syllabus. The time dedicated in this class ensures to provide one-on-one attention to students.
- 4. Critical thinking skills improve largely It is because aspirants need to utilize their brains to create opinions and participate in debates and discussions conducted in the classroom. Participating in discussions will improve the subject-related clarity, thereby improving their performance in the test series and eventually in actual competitive exams.
- 5. Inculcates the habit of discipline As a competitive exam aspirant, discipline bridges the gap between student goals and accomplishment. These courses will build discipline in form of consistent guidance and also boosts confidence.
